





Greetings!

The Republic Act No. 11223 or the Universal Health Care Act enshrines the Department of Health's (DOH) partnership with education national government agencies, specifically the Department of Education (DepEd), in developing schools to become healthy settings and promoting health literacy among Filipino learners. The Health Promotion Framework Strategy (DOH Administrative Order No. 2020-0042) adopts a setting-based approach for health promotion. With a setting-based approach, schools or learning institutions are recognized to be built as an environment that can serve as important avenues to deliver population-based health interventions, age-appropriate health education, as well as the implementation of health promoting policies. To realize this, the JAO No. 2022-002 between DOH, DepEd, CHED, TESDA, LEB, DILG, and DSWD, entitled "Guidelines on Healthy Settings Framework in Learning Institutions" was signed.

The Healthy Learning Institution (HLI) is a concept that emphasizes the importance of creating a conducive and supportive learning environment that promotes the physical, emotional, and mental well-being of students, teachers, and staff in schools. HLI is multifaceted, it can provide basic health services, such as medical check-ups, vaccinations and nutrition programs to ensure students, overall well-being.

As such, the Batanes Provincial Health Office and in partnership with Cagayan Valley Center for Health Development (CVCHD) and Provincial DOH Office (PDOHO) is conducting HLI Workshop 2 for all Elementary School Heads and select Teaching and/or Non-Teaching Staff.

Relative to this, may we invite the following to attend the said workshop on August 27-29, 2024, at Basco, Batanes (venue to be announced). The board and lodging of participants from island municipalities of Sabtang and Itbayat shall be shouldered by the inviting agency, while the travelling expenses shall be borne by the sending agency.





