



SUBJECT : Unloading Operations for the BRP Davao del Sur

DATE : 25 November 2024

This memorandum is to inform all concerned parties about the upcoming continuation of the unloading operations for relief goods via BRP Davao del Sur. The vessel, which has made shelter in Sta. Ana, Cagayan, is scheduled to return tomorrow, 26 November 2024, to resume unloading activities.

Unloading will commence at 5:00 AM. Please report to Ms. Liz Pama at Basco Port for further instructions and to ensure that your office's designated personnel are accounted for and ready to assist. Personal protective equipment (PPE) must be worn by all personnel involved in the operations.

Further, all offices of the Provincial Government of Batanes (PGB) are required to provide at least one Job Order (JO) personnel to assist in the preparation of food, which will take place at Batanes Resort.

Your cooperation and support are crucial for the successful execution of the unloading process. Please ensure that your designated personnel are briefed and prepared for their roles.





- a. Adhere strictly to the instructions provided by the team leaders and safety officers.
- b. Stay hydrated and take short breaks as needed. Water stations will be set up at the port. But we recommend you to get water bottles.
- c. Check the weather forecast and come prepared for any conditions (e.g., rain gear, sunscreen).
- d. Keep personal belongings to a minimum. Secure any valuable items as the Provincial Government is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- e. Only authorized trucks will be allowed to enter the port. Motorcycles may be parked in front of the Provincial Capitol.
