

Madam,

Deaf Awareness Week is observed from Nov. 10 to 16 by virtue of Proclamation No. 829 signed on Nov. 8, 1991 by then President Corazon Aquino. The proclamation cited a need to focus public awareness on deafness prevention and rehabilitation. It is an important occasion to promote understanding and acceptance of Deaf culture and to highlight the contributions of Deaf individuals in our community. This year the Deaf Awareness Week (DAW) will be celebrated with the theme "Overcoming Challenges: Fostering Inclusivity."

We are writing to request the issuance of a memo regarding the upcoming Deaf Awareness Celebration, which will take place from November 10 to November 16, 2024. This celebration aims to promote awareness and appreciation of the Deaf community while fostering an inclusive environment in our school.

As part of the festivities, we have planned several activities that will enhance our understanding of Deaf culture and highlight the importance of using Filipino Sign Language (FSL). The details of the activities are as follows:

November 11 - Deaf Awareness Kick-Off

We invite everyone to join us for the kick-off event, which will feature a talk on Republic Act 11106, the FSL Law. This event will take place at the Philippine School for the Deaf in Pasay City from 8:00 AM to 3:30 PM. We also invite one specialist from the Bureau of Learning Delivery-Student Inclusion Division (1) to deliver a talk on RA 11650 during the opening program.

November 12 - Poster Making Contest

Students will have the opportunity to showcase their creativity by participating in a poster-making contest focused on Deaf awareness and the importance of FSL.

November 13 - Deaf Got Talent

This engaging talent show will highlight the diverse talents of our Deaf students, providing them a platform to share their skills and abilities with the community.







We will conclude the week with an interactive storytelling session where students will narrate stories using Filipino Sign Language, fostering a deeper appreciation for this beautiful mode of communication.


November 15- Closing Ceremony
